## BEFORE SCHOOL PROCEDURES

With the new academic year commencing, a timely reminder about before school procedures. We ask that parents and children **please continue to follow the existing before school procedures.** Children will be supervised in the Undercover Area from 8.15am - 8.30am if they are at school during this time.

- Children are encouraged to sit on the benches in the undercover area during this time and chat to one another. There are too many children in the undercover area for them all to be playing
- Children in Year 4-6 only are permitted to play in the 4-square area once the teacher on duty gives them permission
- When the bell rings at 8.30am all children are to walk to their classroom as this is when classroom doors open

We ask that if parents are waiting with their children in the morning that they do so in the undercover area as this is the waiting area for the children. Please do not wait near the Year 1, Year 2, Year 3, Year 4 classrooms or near the stairwell at the glass doors prior to 8:30am. Please wait in the undercover area as this will greatly assist the teacher on duty in their supervision and duty of care for all children.

If you have a child in PK-PP then you are welcome to wait with your child in the Early Learning Centre however due to duty of care the children **are not permitted** to play on the playground during this time.

We also ask that parents please respect the teachers' time in their classrooms once the doors open and to make an appointment to meet with the teacher before school if required.

For the safety and care of our students your continued support is greatly appreciated.


