Tuesday is staff Catholic Day therefore the school will be closed. Catholic Day is acknowledgement from the Bishops to all staff in Catholic schools of their commitment to evangelisation and catechesis in our communities, much of this after hours.

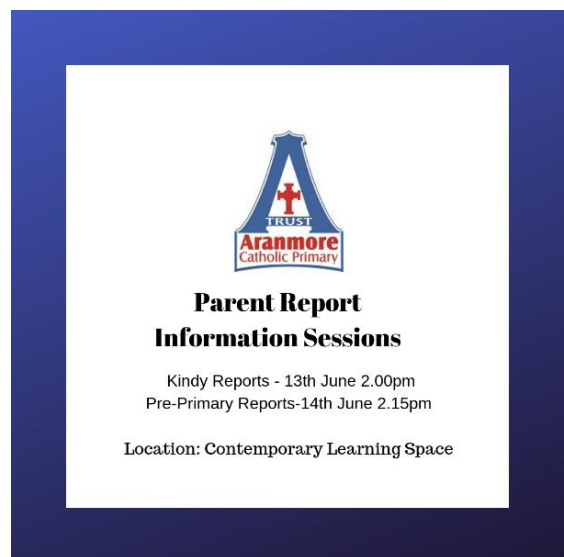
PARENT REPORT INFORMATION SESSION – KINDY & PRE-PRIMARY
