Continuing students are asked to submit a new Instrumental Program Tuition Agreement to confirm their re-enrolment in 2023.

Tutors will contact you in regard to lesson days, times and fees.

Please note that school fee payments must be up to date in order for your child to enrol in the instrumental program.

Instrumental Program 2023 Information Terms and Conditions

Lessons

Students will receive one lesson per week for 30 minutes during school hours on a rotating timetable. Shared or group lessons are available for guitar, the tutor will advise you of the availability and fees involved.

Individual Lessons

\$35 - \$40 per lesson (depending on the instrument)

Payment of Tuition

Instrumental fees are billed separately to School Fees; these must be up-to-date in order for your child to receive lessons. The tutors will provide you with an invoice for the term and advise when the payment is due. Payments are to be made promptly, directly to the tutor before the due date. The Tutors rely on the lesson fees for their income.

Practice and Communication Book

Each student will require a practice and communication book. This should be brought to each lesson so that the lesson details can be recorded by the tutor for the student to follow at home. The students should record their home practice in the book and parents may also use it as a means of communicating with the tutor. Tutors may also be contacted via email or mobile phone; it is important to build a strong partnership between the tutor and the parent to enable the child to succeed.

Purchasing of Materials/Text

Tutors will specify the books required for the student to learn. It is the responsibility of the Parent/Guardian to purchase these books as soon as possible. Tutors are aware of costs and try to keep requests at a minimum.

Withdrawal from Lessons

The period of tuition is for the whole year and children should be encouraged to complete the year. If your child wishes to withdraw from the Instrumental Program, it is required that both the instrumental teacher and the Music Co-ordinator, Ms O'Hara, are informed of this in writing by Week 8 of the current term.

Instruments

Instruments are available to hire from a number of music stores in Perth. Please contact Mrs O'Hara if you require further details. If your child brings their own instrument to school please be aware that it is not covered for theft or damage unless you have made provision for this in your own Home Contents Insurance Policy. It is advisable to check with your insurance company.



Band/Ensembles

Opportunities will arise to participate in the School Band or other ensembles. Mr Holmes directs the band on Friday mornings from 7.45am – 8.45am. Auditions will be held very early in Term 1. Students in Years 5 and 6 who are at a proficient level on their instrument may audition.

Practice

The students need to be encouraged to commit to practise at least five days a week so that they make steady progress. The practice achieved should be recorded in the practice book.

Missed Lessons

You will be charged for the lesson if it is missed due to illness, holiday or a school event and the teacher was not informed. It may be possible to reschedule the lesson, although this cannot be guaranteed.

Any questions or concerns about the instrumental program in general should be directed to the Music Co-ordinator, Ms O'Hara. Once lessons have commenced, please communicate directly with the tutors with regard to lesson content, progress, performance opportunities, exams and fee payment.
