#### ADMINISTRATION

#### SUPERVISION BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL

Please note that supervision of students commences at 8:15am. Consequently, students should not be arriving any earlier as that is when our duty of care commences for the day.

The duty of care of students concludes at 3:20pm each day. When duty ceases in the afternoon, all those students still waiting are asked to sit outside the office for collection by parents. Any children of Kindy or Pre-primary age are asked to sit inside the office to wait for parents.

Our Before and After School Care (Gumtrees) operates from &.00am to 9.00am and in the afternoon from 3.00pm to 6.00pm. If you need to drop your children off prior to 8.15am then please enrol them in the before school programme. If you are unable to collect your children by 3.20pm then please enrol them in the after school programme.

# **EARLY LEARNING CENTRE (PRE-KINDY, KINDY AND PRE-PRIMARY)**

We wish to inform you of some changes in the Early Learning Centre in 2019. Early Learning Centre gates will be open at 8:30am. At 8.30am the parents are invited to assist their children with preparing for the school day by placing down bags and getting their necessary items for class.

The Early Learning Centre Playground is not supervised before or afterschool by a staff member. As the safety of your child is of utmost importance to us we ask that no children are to be playing on the equipment in the Early Learning Centre Playground before or after school.

#### **SIGNING CHILDREN IN AND OUT**

It is important to remember that when your child / children either arrive late for the day or are picked up before the end of the day, that they are signed in or out. The Sign In or Out kiosk is located in the front office.

**Please note**: If you are signing your child out of school, Mrs Ellen will call for your child / children from their class. Parents are asked not to collect their child from class.

#### **KISS AND RIDE**



All parents are to either park in the correct parking zones or use the Kiss and Ride system. The Kiss and Ride system must flow smoothly for the efficiency and safety of our students. We encourage parents to use this

system and be patient while in a queue. Please do not cut in front of other drivers as this could lead to either cars colliding with one another or a student being hurt.

Parents are **NOT** to park in the Kiss and Ride area as it blocks traffic and causes drivers to become very frustrated. Parents are expected to stay in their car if using this system and not get out to open doors or find children. Please follow the flow of cars and the Teacher on duty normally gives direction if 'moving up' is required to make room for other cars waiting in the queue.

Please ensure that the family name tag is clearly displayed – making it easy for the teachers to call out the family name. If you require new or additional name tags – please contact the Office.

Please park in the available parking zones on Brentham Street, Britannia Road, Bennelong Way or Wavertree Place if you would like to walk over to your child / children or visit classroom teachers, etc.

Please read the street signs carefully as they have been changed.

#### The Staff Car Park is only for Staff Parking.

Please refrain from parking in this area to pick up or drop off children.

Thank you for your understanding, patience and assistance in endeavouring to make our school a safe area for the dropping off and picking up of children.
