As part of our School Improvement Plan and Digital Technologies WA Curriculum in relation to **Digital Citizenship** and Cybersafety, we have **Paul Litherland from Surf Online Safe** coming to work with our senior students and staff during the day and then presenting a parent information session **from 6.30pm – 8.00pm Tuesday 27 February in our Hall for all parents from PK-Yr6.** Paul is a highly sought after speaker and I encourage you all to attend as this is the one parent night you do not want to miss!

Paul was a WA Police Officer for over 20 years working in a wide range of different areas, regularly visiting schools across WA conducting "Stranger Danger" talks and working with the Constable Care program. From 2009-2014, he worked at the Technology Crime Investigation Unit, a section internationally recognised as one of the leading technology crime divisions in the world. He worked specifically with children and their families, who were either the victims of online crime, or the offenders themselves. He has dealt personally with the victims of cyber bullying, grooming and predatory behaviour as well as the perpetrators themselves.

He now presents Cybersafety in schools sharing his experience, knowledge and insight into the dangers of the online world and what our children can do to protect themselves. His content, subject knowledge and presentation style, as well as the advice and solutions he offers, come highly recommended.

"As the parent, I can add that extra insight to my presentations as I am more than aware of the fear and apprehension parents have regarding the internet and the dangers that are out there. It is difficult to be a parent in this technological age and this helps me target my presentations more specifically to schools requirements... it is important to take a holistic approach to internet use to make users more aware of risk, rather than simply say "Don't do this" or "Don't do that".
